How can I get a "911" cell phone?

To request a 911 cell phone, merely phone the Armstrong County Area Agency on Aging at 800-368-1066 and ask to speak with Melissa Facemyer, Administrative Assistant, or with any one of the care management staff.

ing, in cooperation with Verizon Wireless/Wireless Zone, is offering "911" cell phones for senior citizens, who are "at risk".

The cell phones are exclusively for emergency use in contacting the local 911 emergency operating center, and they are available free of charge. Verizon Wireless/Wireless Zone is a premium company.

NOTE: These phones CANNOT be used to make calls other than those to 911.

Questions?

Where does the Agency on Aging get the phones?

Verizon Wireless/Wireless Zone collects pre-owned phones, programs and tests them, and donates the phones (and chargers) to the Armstrong County Area Agency on Aging. The Armstrong Co. Area Agency on Aging then distributes the phones.

Are there eligibility criteria?

Although phone recipients must be Armstrong County residents who are at least 60 years of age, there are no other eligibility criteria.



Phones are available upon request on a first-come, first-served basis, contingent upon availability.

****Each phone should be tested in the home for signal coverage prior to relying on it.**
