Dear Hockey Player and Parent,

Enclosed is the registration form for our Learn to Play (LTP) and In House programs. The Learn to Play Program is for skill development only in the ADM format. The purpose of this program is to teach the players the basics of the game while having fun.

All participants will register and pay the Belmont Complex. You need to fill out this registration form (on back) and turn the completed form in to the ticket booth.

**If you are a member of the AAHL or Mini Jacket program, you will be grandfathered into the In House program.**

If you are not playing in either the AAHL or Mini Jacket program and you want to participate in the In House Program you must sign up for Learn to Play to participate in the In House program.

We have equipment rental for ages 5-13 years old, depending on size of the child. Full equipment is required and can be rented for a \$75 deposit and \$50 for skates. Once you return all the equipment, you get your deposit back.

The LTP Class is on Saturdays at 4:00 to 5:00pm for 8 weeks and week 8 is a cross ice ADM format scrimmage. Cost is \$50 for the LTP program. Cross ice or ½ ice games will be played to increase the player's handling of the puck. All players will play every position.

The Learn to Play Hockey Program will have 2 series. Series 1 will start Saturday October 24<sup>th</sup> and Series 2 starts Saturday, January 2<sup>nd</sup>. Registration Deadline for Series 2 LTP will be Wednesday, Dec. 23<sup>rd</sup>, 2015.

**Series 1 Registration Deadline for LTP is Oct. 13<sup>th</sup>. In House registration is Oct. 13<sup>th</sup>. I will be looking for volunteers/on ice coaches & clearances will be required.**

The In House program is subsidized by the Armstrong Hockey Hall of Fame and the Amateur Armstrong Hockey League (AAHL). We are planning on playing some games with Indiana and the Pittsburgh Ice teams. In House starts October 24<sup>th</sup> and there are 2 time slots. 8 & under will play from 5:10 to 6:10pm with cross ice games (ADM format) and 6:15 to 7:15pm for 13 & under full ice games. There will be refs for both divisions.

The In House program allows participants ages 5 thru 13 to enjoy the game on a non-competitive basis. This is a NO check program. Cost is \$140 for this program of 16 sessions. **We will be evaluating players for In House on the 1<sup>st</sup> two sessions so we can make up evenly matched teams for the 14 game season. A jersey will be provided.**

**Each participant must be registered with USA Hockey. Go to the USA Hockey Mid Am website to register.** Cost is \$40 and there may be an affiliate cost as well for \$5. You must provide a confirmation paper to the Belmont to participate. We have goalie equipment for players interested in playing goalie.

Series 2 Learn to Skate starts December 1<sup>st</sup>. Registration deadline is Tuesday, Nov. 17<sup>th</sup>. Cost is \$90 for 8 weeks.

We are hosting the 7<sup>th</sup> annual Little Pens program starting January 30<sup>th</sup>, 2016. All registrations are done through the Pittsburgh Pens web site which is usually in November.
