

**COMMISSIONERS' PUBLIC MEETING**  
**October 21, 2010**

The Armstrong County Board of Commissioners' Public Meeting was called to order on Thursday, October 21, 2010, at 1:30 PM in the Commissioners' Conference Room with the following in attendance: Commissioners Patricia L. Kirkpatrick, Richard L. Fink and James V. Scahill, George J. Ms. Kirkpatrick announced that this meeting is being recorded.

**APPROVAL OF MINUTES**

On a motion by Mr. Fink, seconded by Mr. Scahill and carried unanimously, the minutes for the October 7, 2010 Public Meeting were approved.

**CONTRACTS / AGREEMENTS**

Change Order #2 for the Stairs and Retaining Wall with Palo, Inc.

On a motion by Mr. Scahill, seconded by Mr. Fink and carried unanimously, based on the review of the solicitor and the recommendation of Mr. Carney, the Commissioners acknowledged Change Order #2 for the Stair and Retaining Wall Project with Palo, Inc. Mr. Carney stated that the change order is necessary to approve the requested change of a grade difference to make a reasonable grade. The change order totaled \$4,635.43 and included a special wrap and seal for a gas line.

Mr. Scahill had no comments.

Mr. Fink reminded everyone of the upcoming election to be held on November 2, 2010. He encouraged everyone to participate and exercise their right to vote.

Mr. Fryer inquired the date of the last tax increase for the County. The Commissioners responded that they have not raised taxes in the past five years.
